## **A** Academic Requirements:

## **D** Course History:

Review your course record including completed, in progress, and planned courses. Results can be sorted by course, description, grade, term, units, or status.

## **E** Transcript:


From the My Academics tab you can order an official transcript.

## **F** My Program:

A summary of your current program by career, college/graduate field, and plan.

## Leaving My Academics:

When navigating away from the My Academics tab using the drop down menu at the top of the page, you will see a “Save Warning” popup.
